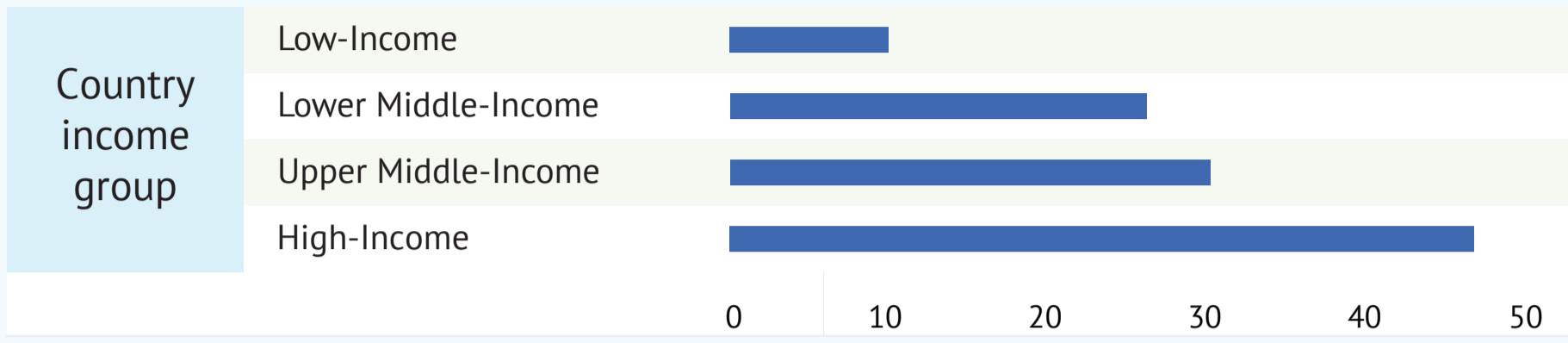


## School Meals Across Income Settings

### COVERAGE

School feeding coverage rates\* across income groups and age groups



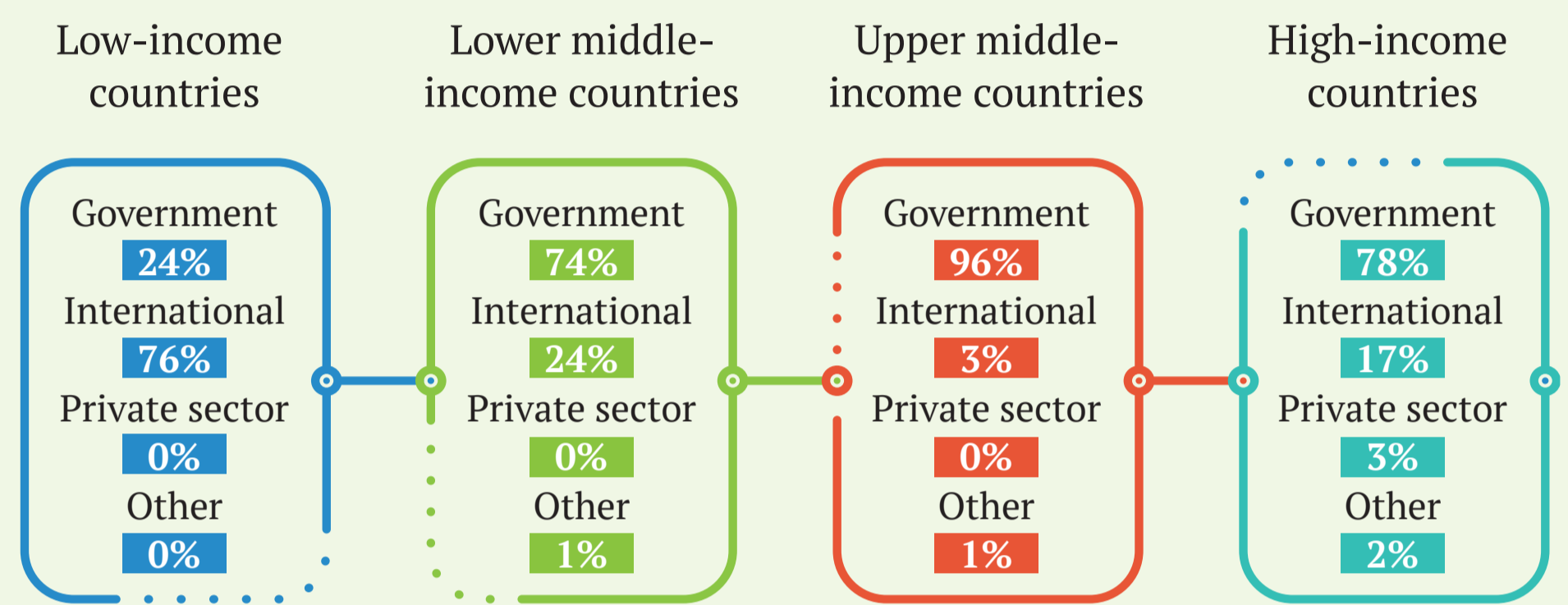
Age group	In all income groups, primary school children are the most likely to receive school food. The gap in coverage for secondary school age children is especially large in low-income countries.

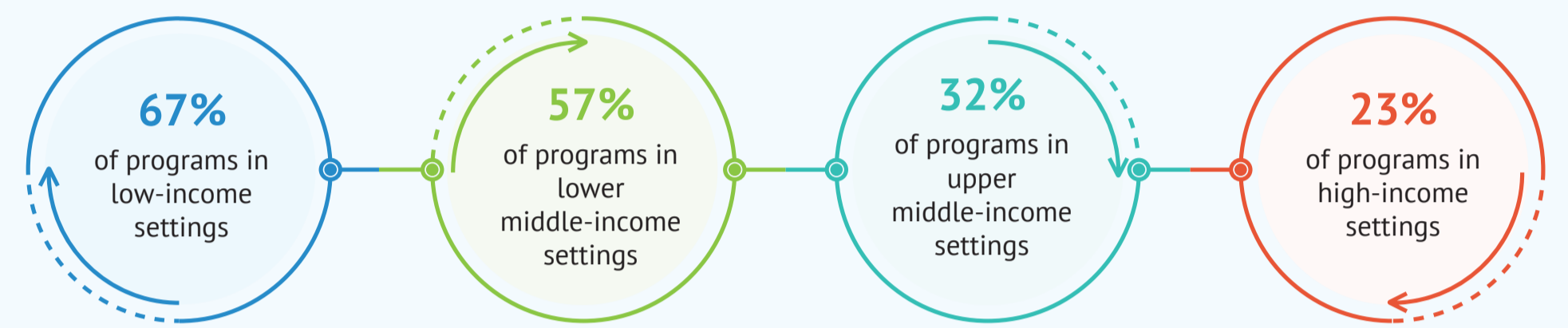

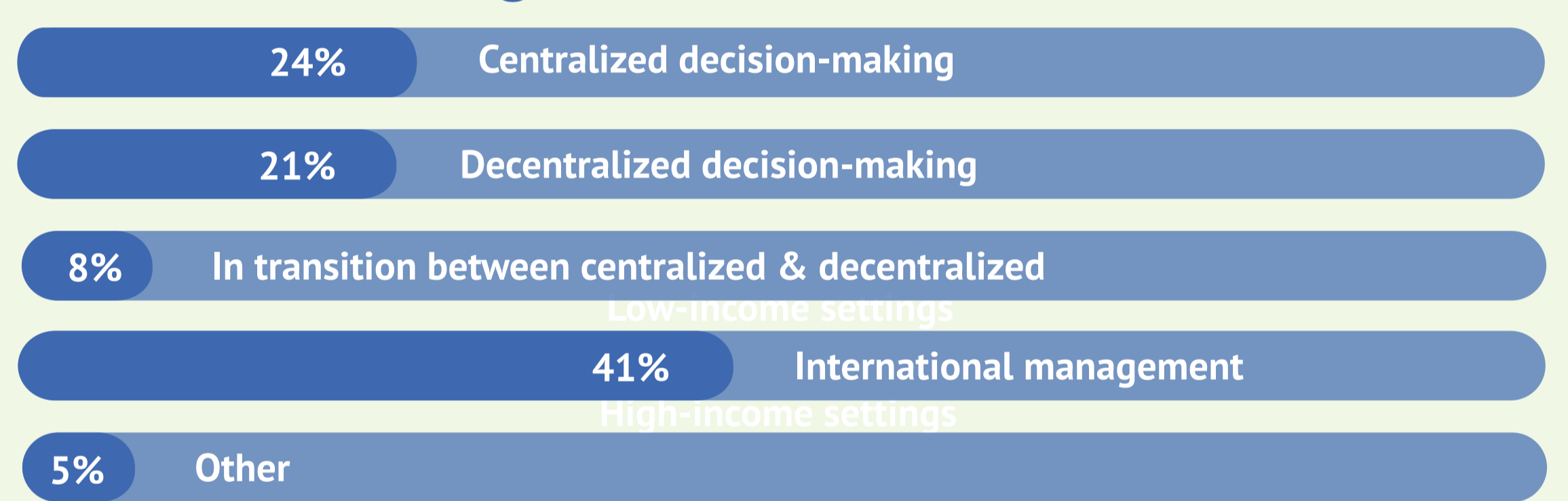

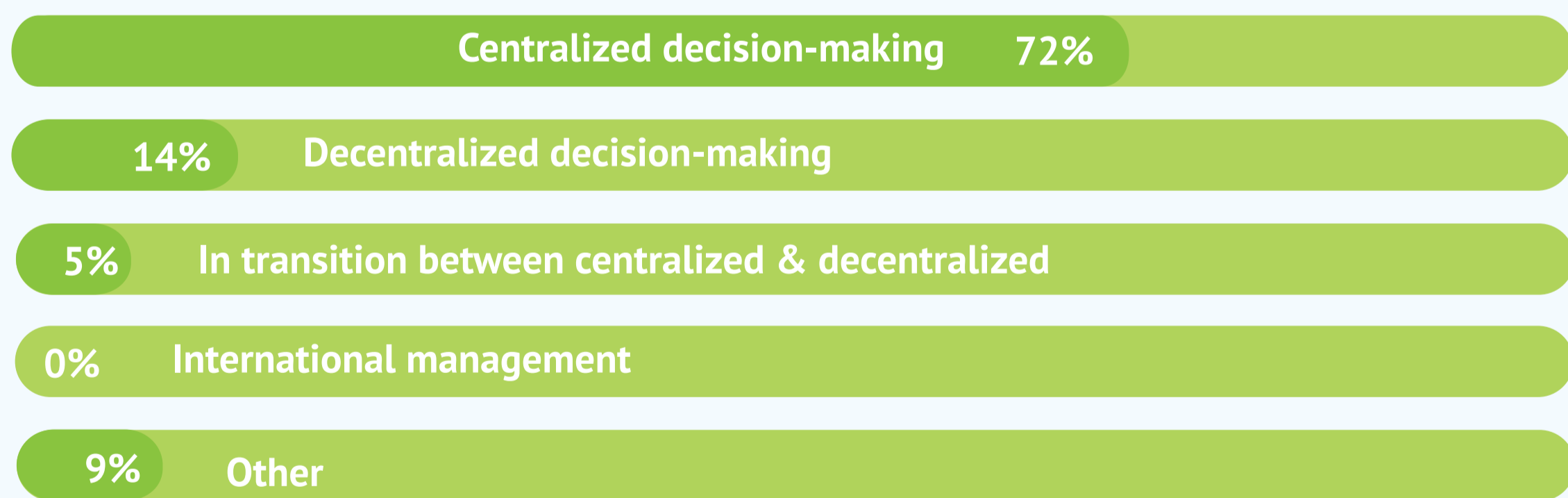
#### Expenditure per recipient child

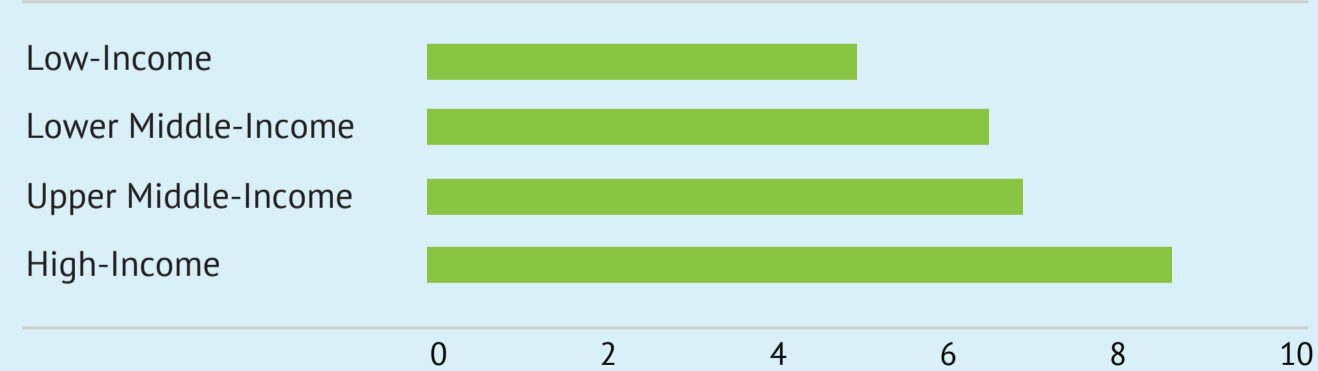

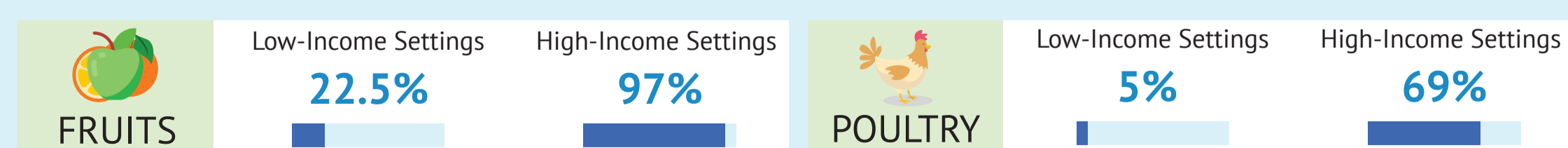
### FOOD BASKET DIVERSITY ACROSS PROGRAMS BY INCOME GROUP
